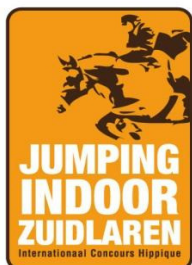

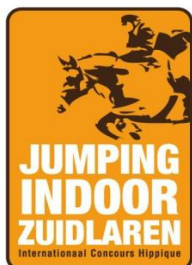

According to the General Regulations of the Royal Dutch Equestrian Federation (KNHS), in accordance with the FEI rules for invitations for CSI 3/CSI 4* events and in order to comply with the special Regulations for international competitions from the Dutch NF (KNHS Art. 65), at least 40% and one Young Rider in addition of the total number will be home athletes. The number of home athletes must not exceed 50% of the total number of athletes invited. CSI-1* riders cannot compete in CSI-3* classes.*

Stabling for each horse participating in the CSI 3* Zuidlaren 2010 is free of charge. All entry and MCP-fees to be paid at the secretary's office on Sunday, 14th February 2010 at the latest.

First bedding will be at the account of the OC. Straw, hay and shavings can be bought at the prizes (excl. 6% VAT) of the day, these will be published at the show office.

No show consequences

Athletes not showing up, following a definite entry of their horses, will afterwards be charged - via their respective NFs - with all stabling fees i.e. € (Euro) 150,00 excl. 6% VAT per horse, definitely entered for the event, and with hotel expenses due, according their specific hotel reservation.

Declining entries

The Organising Committee may at their absolute discretion, with Ground Jury approval, remove any person or animal from the event without being liable for any compensation. No decision will however be taken by the Organising Committee relating to athletes and/or horses participating in international competition without the approval of the Ground Jury.

A) Officials

Officials are the guest of the Organising Committee; hotel accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner will be paid by the Organising Committee (extras: telephone, internet access, beverages, drinks etc. not included).

The hotel rooms will be reserved by the Organising Committee. Costs will be paid for a maximum of 3 nights, from Thursday 11th February 2010 until Sunday 14th February 2010. A longer stay will be at the expense of those concerned. Officials staying in a hotel other than the one selected by the Organising Committee, will have to pay all expenses incurred themselves.

B) Athletes

Cost of hotel accommodation are for the account of the athletes. However, the OC will assist the athletes upon finding hotel accommodation at a favourable rate; therefore all competitors (both foreign and home athletes) are kindly requested to send their requests for hotel accommodation with their definite entries. Hotel reservations will however be done only, after the rider concerned has filled out and signed the event hotel's reservation form. Cost of meals are for the account of the athletes. However, there is a catering possibility at favourable rates for athletes for dinner from 11th February 2010 - 14th February 2010 at the showground in a special athletes and grooms restaurant.

C) Grooms

Grooms (maximum 1 per athlete) will stay at the event at their own expense, however breakfast and dinner will be provided by the O.C. The OC will however assist the grooms upon finding hotel accommodation (if necessary) at a favourable rate; therefore all grooms are kindly requested to send their requests for hotel accommodation with their definite entries! Hotel reservations will however be done only, after the rider / groom concerned has filled out and signed the event hotel's reservation form.

For those staying at the event, the Organising Committee will provide sufficient clean sanitary and showering facilities, with hot and cold water, for male and female grooms.

All athletes (both foreign and home athletes) are kindly requested to send their requests for hotel accommodation with their definite entries. After definite entries no hotel room will be guarantee.

D) Horses

All horses entered for the CSI 3* Zuidlaren 2010 must be 6 or more years old.

Accommodation for the horses in boxes of 3.00 x 3.00 metres, free of charge, will be available for home and foreign athletes in temporary stables, as from Thursday 11th February / 10.00 hrs. for the entire duration of the event. For event in Europe, stabling is free of charge

Since stabling is limited, in principle no stable boxes are available for horses that do not participate in the CSI Zuidlaren 2010. However, if the Organising Committee approves in advance the stabling of an extra horse, an amount of € 150,00 excl. 6 % VAT per horse will be charged to the Person Responsible for each horse not competing in the CSI Zuidlaren - 2010. Requests for extra boxes must be sent with the definite entries.

Dogs are not allowed in the Prins Bernhardhoeve, this includes the stable-area of Jumping Indoor Zuidlaren.

Athletes and/or grooms will not be allowed to erect extra stabling facilities or to erect any private stable shelters.

Cancellation of stabling:

Applications for refund of charges, received by the Organising Committee later than Friday 5th February 2010, will under no circumstances be considered.

Transport of horses

All transport expenses to be paid by the athletes themselves; there will be no reimbursement of travelling expenses by the Organising Committee.

Additional Fees

Electric power for horse lorries/caravans etc. is available at a rate of € 30,00 (Euro) excl. 6% VAT per item for the entire duration of the event. For the required health certificate, the O.C. will be charged to the person responsible a rate of € 25,00 (Euro) excl. 6% VAT per paper. If the Organising Committee approves in advance the stabling of an extra horse or extra box, an amount of € 150,00 excl. 6 % VAT per horse / box will be charged to the Person Responsible

E) Welcome

The time and date of arrival of athletes and horses and their means of transport must be given to the Organising Committee in order to facilitate them on arrival. However, horses may not arrive earlier than Thursday 11th February / 10hrs00 and must depart no later than Monday 15th February 2010 / 10hrs00, unless otherwise agreed upon in advance with the Organising Committee.

F) Local transportation

Courtesy cars will only be available for transport from the official event hotel to the showground of jumping indoor Zuidlaren vice versa. The service will start on Thursday 11 February 2009 and will be continued on through Sunday 14 February 2010. Courtesy car services will daily be continued until one hour after the finish of the last competition of the day.

G) Advertising and publicity on athletes and horses

The athletes are authorised to carry the logo of their personal sponsor in accordance with FEI-GR Art. 136. The Chief Steward will however be responsible to ensure that, before allowing athletes into the arena to compete, the sponsor logos on the saddlecloth and on athletes' clothing are within the limitations as laid down in art. 136 of the FEI General Regulations.

Athletes not complying with art. 136 will be reported to the Ground Jury and will not be permitted into the arena during the course of the competition, until the use of the sponsor's logo is in compliance with this article.

1. GENERAL CLASSIFICATION AT THE END OF THE COMPETITIONS

Leading athlete award - no

PRIZE - CLASSIFICATION (Art. 126, 127, 128)

Prizes in kind will be distributed during the prize giving ceremony in the main arena. The prize-money will be distributed at the Show office at the latest after the last competition. Each competitor will receive his/her prize-money by bank transfer. At the end of the Event the O.C will provide each rider with a breakdown of Prize Money won. Twenty-five percent of participants per competition must receive prize money (one prize for each group of four commenced competitors or part thereof).

All entree fees have to be paid at the latest on Sunday 14th February 2010 at the Show office. The account will be made, based upon the definite entries. Payments must be made in € (Euro) in cash or by credit card (will be debited by a levy of 6% over the total amount due). An ATM will be available at the show office as well. No Cheques will be accepted as means of payment. The O.C. reserves the right to withhold money due from the prize-money won, as long as outstanding bills have not been paid.

Up to an amount of € 250,= maximum, prize money will be paid by the Organising Committee in cash to the relevant athlete; in case the amount of prize money won exceeds the maximum mentioned above, prize money will be transferred to the athlete's bank account, within 14 days after the conclusion of the event. According to the relevant Dutch tax regulations, the Organising Committee of CSI Zuidlaren 2010 must charge 6% VAT on all fees to be paid by athletes. Athletes will receive an invoice, showing VAT specified separately and can apply for re-imburement of all VAT paid at the CSI Zuidlaren 2010 by filling out a form to request this refund of VAT by the Dutch tax authorities.

Within six months maximum after the end of the year in which the event took place. Requests for amounts smaller than € (EUR) 27,00 will not be taken into consideration. Any such request can be handed in once a year only.

3. PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

6 riders have to present themselves each prize-giving ceremony except for the Grand prix, where 8 riders have to be present. If a rider is not present at the prize giving ceremony he/she loses the rights to the prize-money won at that class.

4. DEDUCTIONS FROM PRIZE MONEY

In accordance with the relevant specific Dutch tax regulations, no income tax will be deducted from prizes won by home athletes or by foreign athletes from a country with which the Netherlands have made a treaty in order to avoid double income tax levies. However, 20% income tax will be deducted from prize money won by foreign athletes, domiciled in a country with which The Netherlands do not have a similar tax treaty.

In all cases, athletes will be invited to provide all necessary information, in order to guarantee the correct tax procedure; to this purpose all athletes must provide the Organising Committee with a copy of the relevant pages of their passport and their home address. Every athlete is responsible for the correctness of the details he/she submits.

5. INSURANCES / RESPONSIBILITY

All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

The Organising Committee (including their employees, representatives and show officials) will not be responsible for any accident, injury or damage that may occur to, or any illness or disease which may be contracted by any horse entered at the CSI 3* Zuidlaren 2010, however occurring, and the athletes shall keep the Organising Committee indemnified against all liability whatever arising from any accident, injury, damage, illness or disease.

The Organisers will not be in any way liable for anything that may happen (from any cause or circumstances whatever) to property brought into the event or for any other loss, claim, matter, circumstance or event whatever in connection with, or arising out of, or attributable to the actions of the Organising Committee (including their employees, representatives and show officials) or any of their officers, or agents or these or any other rules or regulations special conditions prescribed by the event.

Each athlete will be considered responsible in all aspects for the attendants in charge of his horses and for any other servants or agents of his for the consequences of any infringement by any such persons of these rules and regulations.

6. EVENT'S ORGANISATION

In exceptional circumstances, together with the approval of the Ground Jury the Organising Committee reserves the right to modify the schedule in order to clarify any matters or matters arising from an omission or due to unforeseen circumstances.

Any such changes will be notified to all athletes and officials as soon as possible and they will be reported to the Secretary General of the FEI by the Foreign Judge. All modifications made to the schedule after approval by the Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) must have the approval of the Secretary General of the FEI.

Having received Ground Jury approval the Organising Committee may alter the timings or cancel any of the competitions, as necessities of the programme may require.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to take all necessary action, including cancelling or shortening the CSI Zuidlaren - 2010, due to special and/or unforeseen circumstances, which in the opinion of the Organising Committee, would make the continuation of the event unjustified; any such decision will be taken in agreement with the Secretary General of the FEI.

No consequential liability whatsoever can be accepted in such occasion. Gen.Reg. 115.1 and 115.2.
Entry fees paid will however be returned.

When, in the opinion of the Show's veterinary surgeon, a horse is so severely injured that it ought to be humanely destroyed, the Person Responsible will where possible first be informed. However, the Show's veterinary surgeon will proceed with humane destruction, without reference to the PR, in order to prevent undue suffering to the horse. Before taking this action, the Show's veterinary surgeon will, wherever practicable, seek a second veterinary opinion. In such eventuality, owners are responsible for the cost of disposal.

7. PRIVATE VETERINARY SURGEONS

Private veterinaries will have to report to the FEI Veterinary Delegate upon their arrival at the show grounds, before they will be accredited and be allowed to enter the restricted area.

Under no circumstance will any veterinary surgeon other than the veterinary commission be allowed to treat any horse at the CSI 3* Zuidlaren - 2010, unless permission in writing has been received from the FEI Veterinary Delegate. If permission is given, the veterinary concerned will be accompanied by the FEI Veterinary Delegate or by his representative.

8. STABLES

All horses, entered for the competitions of the CSI 3* Zuidlaren - 2010 must be stabled in the official stables provided by the Organising Committee (immediately after the official horse inspection) for the entire duration of the event.

They are not to be removed between the dates of Thursday February 11th 2010 and the last competition on Sunday February 12th 2010, in accordance with the relevant FEI rules.

Smoking inside the stables is strictly prohibited; offences against this rule, first will incur a fine and in case of a repeated offence, will lead to permanent exclusion from the stables by withdrawal of the accreditation of the person concerned.

ECSCs must be obtained from the stable managers office upon arrival at the event. It is the responsibility of the athlete/groom to complete the card in full and affix to their horses stable door for the duration of their stay at the show.

Whilst every reasonable effort will be made to contact the owner/person responsible of the animal, if unsuccessful the Veterinary Surgeon on duty will treat the animal as he finds necessary.

10. IDENTIFICATION

For identification purpose all horses stabled must carry their identification number whenever leaving the stables; offences against this rule will incur a fine.

VIII. GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. ENTRY RIGHT TO SHOWGROUNDS

There will be free access to the show grounds for the athletes, their partners, grooms, owners of participating horses and officials. The necessary accreditation should be collected from the secretary's office upon arrival.

Per competitor 1 groom maximum will be accredited. A maximum of two owners per participating horse, will be accredited, providing their names are duly registered as such in the official FEI-passport of the relevant horse. The O.C. Committee reserves the right to withdraw, confiscate or otherwise any passes whether issued with entry or purchased, without refund, immediately in the event that they are either cut, removed or in any way damaged. Passes are non-transferable once issued. All athletes, owners, grooms and other persons must display relevant passes at all times, otherwise entry will be refused.

2. START LISTS & RESULT SHEETS

The name of the owner of each horse will be added to all start lists and result sheets, as well as its stud book initials, country of birth, sire, dam's sire, sex and age.

3. DECLARATIONS

No horse will be permitted to compete in any competition, unless the declaration has been made within at the latest 30 minutes after the prize giving ceremony of the last competition of the day.

4. PRACTICE ARENA

Training (including working, lunging and walking) of horses is only allowed at specified times on the official and controlled exercise areas, provided by the O.C. from Thursday 11th February 2010 until Sunday 14th February 2010. The exercise / practice areas will be permanently controlled by FEI stewards. During a competition the exercise/practice areas will be strictly reserved to horses starting in the present competitions and the next three athletes must be mounted and ready to enter the arena. If an athlete is not ready when his/her starting number/name is called, he/she will lose his/her place in the starting order and he/she will be eliminated from that competition at the discretion of the Ground Jury, unless certain circumstances prevent this (e.g. losing a horse shoe just before his/her turn to start).

5. IMAGE RIGHTS

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to use - without any compensation due - photographs, slides, video tapes or any other (digital) registered picture from athletes and/or horses, made or registered during Jumping Indoor Zuidlaren - 2010, for promotional and/or marketing purposes, related to the event. It is a condition of entry that all athletes will permit any photographic or filmed material derived during the course of the event, to be utilized subsequently by the Organizing Committee for future promotion of their business interests or the show at no cost to the latter.

6. INCIVILITY

Any act of discourtesy or disobedience to any judge, steward or any show officials on the part of the athlete, groom, driver or agent of a horse may at the discretion of the President of the Ground Jury disqualify that horse from being judged, in which case entry fees, prizes and charges will be forfeited.

7. FINAL CONDITION

By entering a horse into Jumping Indoor Zuidlaren - 2010, the Person Responsible fully accepts the conditions of the schedule and of the programme itself, applicable for the athletes, grooms and the horses.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

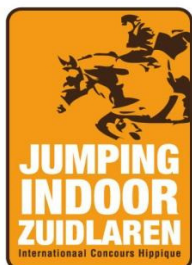
1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

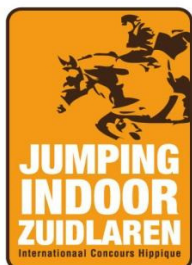

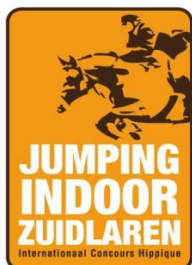
